Breakfast Club

Monday to Friday - 8am-8.45am

Our Breakfast Club offers a safe and fun environment for children. Each child will be given a choice of cereals, toast with toppings, fruit, milk, juice or water. This club will be held in the Acorn Room and entrance is through the gate to the right of the main office. This gate will be opened promptly at 8am.

Bookings must be made at least one day in advance through [Parentpay](#) and payment of £2.50 per session must be made at the time of booking.

Stay and Play

Monday to Friday - 3.15pm to 5.30pm

Stay and Play will offer a safe and fun environment for children, with activities such as board games, reading, time for homework and socialising. Each child will be given a snack such as toast, biscuit, fruit, milk, juice or water.

This club will be held in the Activity or Nursery Room and during good weather the children will also have access to the playground.

Bookings must be made at least one day in advance through [Parentpay](#) and payment of £6 per session must be made at the time of booking.

A late charge of £3 per 15mins (or part thereof) is made if you collect your child after 5.30pm. This is because we have to pay staff and our site manager overtime. We reserve the right to increase the session charge should it not cover our costs and if this is necessary, 6 weeks notice will be given. Please also note that should you be late collecting your child and we have not received any communication from you, we may have to take further steps and contact social services or the police.

Your child may attend another school run club and then come to Stay and Play if they wish but the session cost will remain the same.

For collection parents and carers will need to come through the gate to the right of the main office and ring the bell on the gate to alert staff.
